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

Description

Stitched Textiles: Nature is the fourth title in this successful theme-based series. It contains an extensive section on techniques, featuring step-by-step guides to machine- and hand-stitching, attaching embellishments and found objects to your work; painting and printing on fabrics including cotton, silk and Khadi paper; and using objects found in nature, such as leaves, to make unique and iconic prints.

The book includes three beautiful, inspirational projects based on different facets of the natural world: Ocean, Rainforest, Botany, Birds and Animals. *Stitched Textiles: Nature* also features examples of the author, Stephanie Redfern's own intricate and detailed works based on nature, exploring the means by which the pieces have been created, and the wonderful stories behind Stephanie's journey as an artist.

The wealth of information and visual stimuli in *Stitched Textiles: Nature* is intended to inspire the reader to create their own works inspired by nature. Stephanie begins by exploring the use of sketchbooks and study pages; progressing to picking out iconic elements from sketches and photographs; and eventually assembling a stunning, personal piece of stitched textile work on fabric or on cotton-blend Khadi paper; applying handstitch in metallic threads; machine stitch in whimsical and beautiful patterns; embellishing with natural beads or found objects.

Four pieces of lining fabric for the passport holder measuring 10 x 30 cm (3.9 x 11.8 inches)
Two pieces of outer fabric for the two pockets measuring 10 x 30 cm (3.9 x 11.8 inches)
Two pieces of magnetic tape
One piece of outer fabric for the wallet flap measuring 4 x 20 cm (1.6 x 7.9 inches)
Two pieces of outer fabric for the wallet flap measuring 4 x 20 cm (1.6 x 7.9 inches)



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1 Take the two wallet flap pieces and cut out a name tag shape from the outer fabric using the name tag template. Apply one half of the magnetic clasp to the wrong side of the outer fabric. Place the curved side of the name tag over the magnetic clasp and sew the two flap pieces right sides together. Turn the name tag to the outside and press. Turn the outer fabric right side out. Press again. Turn the outer fabric right side out. Turn the name tag to the outside and press. 
2 From the interfacing to the wrong side of the 10x25 (30x60) square of outer fabric, measure and mark the top edge 1 cm (0.4 in) from the top edge and 1 cm (0.4 in) from the bottom edge. Measure 1 cm (0.4 in) down from the top. Apply the second half of the magnetic clasp to the outer fabric. Place the name tag and the two flap pieces right sides together. Turn the outer fabric right side out. Turn the name tag to the outside and press. Turn the outer fabric right side out. Press again.

INTRODUCTION

Using step-by-step techniques, this book shows how to draw a good selection of wild animals, starting off with basic shapes and building up forms to create complete images. I have included a mixture of poses, including details of heads and shoulders, as well as full body illustrations. Movement is important and so I have included many dynamic poses.

Each sequence begins with simple shapes drawn in pencil. For each subsequent step new lines are drawn using brown pencil, with the previous pencil lines being rubbed out with a white eraser. If you prefer not to use an eraser, you should use graphite pencil throughout all the stages apart from the final picture, where I have used coloured pencils. You can use, of course, whatever materials you like, as long as they are suitable for drawing on paper. I have used charcoal and pastels, as well as watercolours, which can be used as a basis for most drawing and painting methods.

At the bottom of each page are two illustrations: an intermediate stage and the final colour stage. The intermediate stage is drawn in pencil showing tone, or form and texture, of the animal. If you want to take the drawing to the finished colour stage, this tonal image will help you with your stroke. Tone is important in drawing as it helps to define the form of the animal at each stage and form much better than if you use colour. The tonal qualities can then be translated into colour in the final drawing.

Don't be afraid to experiment and, if you can, use a variety of mediums. The more you practise, the easier the drawing process will become.


You may want to use your own ideas, or you might want to draw a picture of your own family, or you can use old photographs.

Local parks are a great source of ideas, as are zoos and nature reserves. Local libraries can be a rich source of ideas, or surfing the internet with search engines can also be useful. For more inspiration, look at the work of other artists, David Shepherd, Robert Bateman, Alan Hunt and Terry Isaac are a few of my favourites. Do be aware though, if you do copy another artist's work, you must ask permission to do this. If you do not, you could well be in breach of copyright law.

When you feel you have practised enough and if you are feeling more confident, you can move on to drawing from life.

Each one will be different, even males and females of the same species can vary considerably. You may want to include reptiles, insects and domestic animals. Drawing from life will help you to understand the form and movement of the shapes, and build up images in easy stages. Finally, use this book to practise and develop your observation skills. Draw what you see, not what you think it seems. Above all else, enjoy yourself!


