Inspired by the grand landscape tradition from JMW Turner to Alexander Nasmyth, Sandra applies contemporary pastel and charcoal methods to develop epic representational works that convey the terrible beauty of wild open spaces.

Sandra has a degree in Fine Art and many years experience as an art teacher and tutor. She regularly exhibits at both local and national shows as well as galleries, and has exhibited with The Pastel Society at the Mall Galleries in London. Sandra is a member of the art collective, Peak District Artisans, and has contributed to SAA and *The Artist* magazines. Making gnome bodies & features

The bodies of gnomes in this book come in two sizes: small and large. Each body is made for the same size.

The fun part is adding the features! Add arms and legs or hands and feet, or leave them off if you prefer.

In several moments the gnomes will have colorful eyes and a smile with a pink nose, a black mustache, a white beard, and a red hat.

BODIES



YOU WILL NEED

- SMALL BODY:
 - 30 x 30 (12 x 12) cm (12 x 12) sq of fabric
 - 7 mm (1/4") diameter circle of the same fabric (see page 75)
- LARGE BODY:
 - 60 x 60 (24 x 24) cm (24 x 24) sq of fabric
 - 14 mm (1/2") diameter circle of the same fabric (see page 75)



- 1 Cut out the fabric to the size required. Sew the short ends or the long edge sides together to make a tube.
- 2 Lay your tube inside out. It is longer (about 10%) than you need. Sew around the flat end to gather and the opening is slightly smaller than the other. You should also do this by hand, with some gathering stitches (see page 12).
- 3 Pin the tube to the gathered edge, adjusting the gathers so evenly fit over the cap. Cut the length of the tube to match the head (see page 12).
- 4 Pin the tube into the tube (see page 12). Then stuff the body firmly with the fiber.

- 2 Turn each hand right side out and stuff with the fiber.
- 3 Sew the feet template and mark 2 lines. Sew the feet together with the same fabric. Sew the feet to the body (see page 12) to make it easier to insert the feet. Sew the feet to the body (see page 12).
