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Hanging Hearts

Love Heart

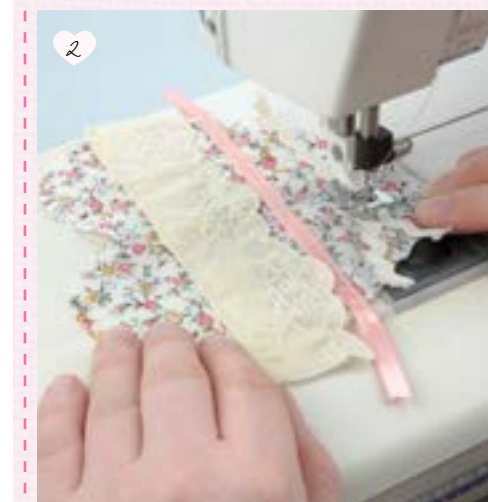
Materials

- ✦ pattern piece B (page 62)
- ✦ floral fabric, 37 x 16cm (14½ x 6¼in)
- ✦ small pieces of lace, ric-rac and ribbon, long enough to fit across the heart
- ✦ satin ribbon, 28cm (11in) long
- ✦ three or more wooden buttons
- ✦ stuffing
- ✦ matching thread

Tools

- ✦ sewing machine
- ✦ fabric scissors
- ✦ hand-sewing needle
- ✦ pins

- 1 Fold the floral fabric in half, right sides together. Pin on pattern piece B and cut out.
- 2 Take one heart and arrange the pieces of ribbon, lace and ric-rac across the shape at different angles. Pin in place and sew in matching thread.
- 3 Pin the two heart pieces together, right sides facing, and sew around the shape with a 1cm (½in) seam allowance, leaving a gap for turning through and backstitching at the beginning and end of the stitch line.
- 4 Clip the curves and point of the heart and turn through. Roll the seams gently to improve the shape and stuff with small pieces of stuffing. Hand sew the opening closed.
- 5 Sew on a button (or buttons) for decorative detail. Position the ribbon for the hanging loop, following the photograph for guidance, and sew it in place with small stitches. Place buttons over the top of the stitches and sew in place. Trim the ends of the ribbon to neat points.
